

President's October Update 2021

My fellow Members,

The NSW State Government has announced that as of the 11th of October 2021 the state will come out of lockdown. The NSSC will open both Clubs in accordance with the guidelines and restrictions as set out by the NSW Government.

I would like to bring all members up to date on how we will open and what has been happening since being in lockdown for 8 weeks.

Club Opening.

Both Clubs will open on the 11th of October 2021 under the following restrictions.

- Both Clubs will open under strict Covid health protocols and procedures.
- Patrons will be required to be fully vaccinated to enter both clubs, including outdoor & sporting facilities, and proof of double vaccination will be required. Only exemption will be medical grounds with proof.
- Face masks must be worn.
- Sporting facilities will open
- Bingo will start at Club Narooma on Wednesday and Club Dalmeny on Thursday.
- No raffles until November.
- 4 square metre rule will apply within both clubs until the 1st December 2021.
- All rules and guidelines will be displayed at both clubs,

During the lockdown the following has been completed or moved.

Club Narooma

The major internal renovations being carried out by Edwards Construction are now complete. The new outdoor locker room for the bowlers should be completed this month. The new outdoor sign has been installed.

Club Dalmeny

The final plans have been drawn up and agreed to by the board. The plans were lodged with council in late September to obtain a DA. Copies of the plans will be on display in both clubs. An information session will be held at Club Dalmeny as soon as possible

The NSSC took part in an independent survey that was carried out by Roar Research on behalf of Clubs NSW. I would like to thank the 375 members who took part. Your comments have been noted and a review will be carried out by the club.


I would also ask all members not to take any frustrations out on the staff. They are only trying to do their job in difficult times.
